

SSNMH Privacy Policy

- The Network will ensure that anyone from whom personal data is obtained knows who is collecting the data. We will explain why and how the information will be used.
- Some personal data is classified as 'sensitive'. Examples include the Data Subject's racial or ethnic origin, beliefs, mental or physical health conditions, sexual orientation etc... Consent to collect sensitive data will be obtained from the Data Subject. Sensitive data will only be requested when it is clearly required for the purpose for which it is being asked.
- The Network will offer Data Subjects the opportunity to 'opt out' of some uses of the data such as direct marketing, disclosure to other organisations, or use for secondary purposes.
- The Network will not use personal data until consent is given.
- Any data that is collected by The Network on behalf of a third party must be authorised. It must only be done in the Data Subject's best interest.
- Personal data will only be disclosed if the disclosure fits the purpose for which the data is being held. No information will be disclosed without establishing that the recipient is authorised to receive it. If a disclosure is made, where reasonable, The Network will inform the Data Subject.
- We use Google Analytics to see how many people view our website. We do not use Google Analytics for anything else other than that.
- Personal data will only be uploaded on the Internet (i.e. our website) with the consent of the Data Subject.
